James Hunt, a British driver born on 29 August 1947 in Belmont, England, competed in his first F1 Grand Prix event in Monaco in 1973. He became world champion in 1976, defeating Niki Lauda by a single point in the overall ranking. He ended his career in 1979 and died prematurely of a heart attack on 15 June 1993.

NEW FIRST DAY COVER (FDC)

The new envelope, which represents the Prince's Palace, is available for all 2017 postage stamps. The price is the facial value of the stamp added to € 0,50 for the small envelope and € 0,60 for the large one. The format of the envelope is decided by the Head Office according to the size of the stamps. Besides, no blank FDC are on sale.

**THE YERSIN**

Designed in Concarneau and owned by François Fiat, the *Yersin* is a 76.60-metre yacht, which serves as both a luxury cruiser and a platform for scientific exploration, much like the *Calypso* many years before it. The vessel's steel and aluminium hull means that it is capable of navigating all of the world's seas and oceans, including under extreme conditions and in the polar regions. The

yacht's name pays tribute to Alexandre Yersin (1863–1943), a doctor with the Messageries Maritimes merchant shipping company, who discovered the bacillus responsible for bubonic plague in 1894. The *Yersin* was blessed by the Vicar General of Monaco, Monseigneur René Giuliano, at a ceremony in the Principality attended by H.S.H. Prince Albert II. The yacht can host children on board to raise their awareness of the need to protect the marine environment. One such mission has already been carried out with H.S.H. Princess Charlene of Monaco.

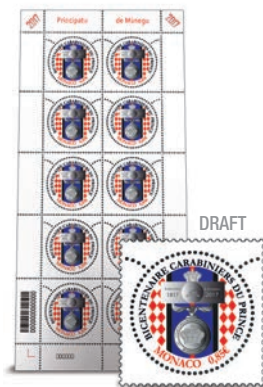

BICENTENARY OF THE PALACE GUARDS

The Palace Guards Corps was established on 8 December 1817 by the Prince de Valentinois, Honoré Grimaldi, Hereditary Prince of Monaco and Administrator of the Principality, in the name of his father, Prince Honoré IV. In 1904, Prince Albert I, satisfied with the policing and guard duties carried out by the "carabiniers", entrusted them with the security of the Palace and Royal Family. The Ordinance specified that "the service provided by the Company of Guards shall henceforth be provided by the Palace Guards." The unit was given the name *Compagnie des Carabiniers du Prince*.

CENTENARY OF THE BATTLE OF CHEMIN DES
DAMES

Prince Louis II, who volunteered to serve in the French Army from August 1914, particularly distinguished himself during the battle of Chemin des Dames, which lasted from 16 April to 24 October 1917. He received a mention in the dispatches of the Army Corps, which earned him the Croix de Guerre with silver gilt star.

It was brought to the big screen in 1971 by Stanley Kubrick. Anthony Burgess is one of the co-founders of the Princess Grace Irish Library, opened in Monaco in 1984.

100th ANNIVERSARY OF THE BIRTH OF AIMÉ BARELLI

Aimé Barelli, born on 1 May 1917 in Loda (Lantosque, Alpes-Maritimes), was a conductor, composer, singer and jazz trumpeter. From 1940 to 1945, he was at the forefront of the French scene, with a fascinating technique and dexterity in scaling the treble range. He was also known for his dynamism and for the elegance of his phrasing. He rubbed shoulders and played with some of the greatest names in jazz, including Louis Armstrong, Frank Sinatra, Sammy Davis Jr., Marlene Dietrich, Arthur Briggs, Nat King Cole, Henri Contet (Edith Piaf's lyricist) and Django Reinhardt to name but a few. Artists such as Claude François and André Ceccarelli made their debut in his orchestra. In 1949, he moved to Monaco and, for more than 25 years, he led the ensembles at the Cabaret and Sporting Club, where he presented some of the Principality's leading events (the Red Cross Gala, Rose Ball, etc.).
