MONACO EXPLORATIONS

On 4 April, H.S.H. Prince Albert II launched the 2017–2020 Monaco Explorations initiative, reviving, after a gap of 120 years, the maritime scientific explorations pioneered by His great-great-grandfather Prince Albert I. The *Yersin*, an environmental research vessel which sails under a Monegasque flag, will depart next August from the Port of Monaco. It will follow a longitudinal route between the Tropics, completing a circumnavigation of the globe over a period of three years. The initiative will be based on the recommendations of a Scientific Guidance Committee made up of 10 internationally renowned scientists. Science will therefore be the foundation of the project, complemented by awareness-raising, communication and media activities.

THE FORBIDDEN CITY IN MONACO

The major exhibition event of the summer at the Grimaldi Forum will be devoted to "The Forbidden City in Monaco: Imperial Court Life in China". From 14 July to 10 September, the Forbidden City, the hub of political decision-making as well as a centre of culture and religion, will provide a showcase for a vast historical panorama presented via more than 250 works, mostly from the Museum of the Forbidden City. Works of calligraphy, paintings, ceramics, furniture, jade and liturgical objects will illustrate the refinement of traditional Chinese culture. This culture was to reach its peak under the emperors of the last feudal dynasty, the Qing – the period on which the exhibition focuses – which reigned from 1644 to 1911, the year the Republic of China was established.



Following an exceptional season, the Monaco Football Club AS, chaired by Dmitri Rybolovlev, won its eighth French League 1 title, seventeen years after its last coronation. Under Leonardo Jardim's leadership, the Club seduced by its game's quality and the presence of spectacular players. Performance is historical : 95 points and 97 goals scored, i.e. for each of them the 2nd and 3rd best results of the League 1 history.

DURAS

On 4 July, H.S.H. Prince Albert II trod the path of his Duras ancestors as he paid a visit to the Castle of the Dukes. The Grimaldis share a common ancestry with the Durfort family, who owned the castle for nearly 500 years. The first wife of Emmanuel Félicité, Duke of Duras, was Charlotte-Antoinette, a descendant of Hortense Mancini, the niece of Cardinal Mazarin. From this union was born Louise-Jeanne de Durfort, Duchess of Mazarin, who passed her titles on to her daughter, Louise d'Aumont. The latter would go on to become a princess of Monaco when she married Prince Honoré IV in 1771.

MARSHAL OF MATIGNON

Jacques II de Goyon, the lord of Matignon, was Marshal of France and Mayor of Bordeaux from 1585 to 1597, a position he inherited from his friend Michel de Montaigne. One of his descendants, Jacques Goyon de Matignon, Count of Torigni, became a prince of Monaco under the title Jacques I after his marriage to Louise-Hippolyte of Monaco in 1715. H.S.H. Prince Albert II travelled to Bordeaux on 5 July.

TITTA RUFFO

Titta Ruffo (1877–1953) was an Italian baritone who performed at the Monte-Carlo Opera on many occasions. His first performance on the Monegasque stage was in Rossini's *The Barber of Seville* in 1907. He played Figaro, one of his signature roles. Blessed with a voice of exceptional power, he sang at the official opening of the Oceanographic Museum in Monaco from a raft in the middle of the harbour.

AUDIOVISUAL ARCHIVES OF MONACO

Created in 1997, the Audiovisual Archives of Monaco Association aims to record, collect, restore, protect, conserve, disseminate and showcase all of the sounds, images and audiovisual documents, professional or amateur, relating to the Principality of Monaco. The technical equipment available to the Audiovisual Archives allows the Principality's audiovisual heritage to be disseminated under the brand "Monaco on film". Since 2004, the association has been engaged in an initiative to promote film art and culture by organising an annual series of screenings known as "Cinema Tuesdays".

SEPAC – CRAFTSMANSHIP

Ever conscious of its artistic influence, Monaco opened its own ceramics studio in 1874. The Principality's first pottery offered an extensive and varied range. After it closed down in 1884, Prince Albert I opened Monaco's second pottery in 1907. This one ceased operating in 1914. A few studios continue to produce ceramics to this day, carrying on the tradition of Monegasque art pottery.

ARMAND LUNEL

A French writer who was born in 1892 in Aix-en-Provence and died in 1977 in Monaco, Armand Lunel passed the philosophy high-level competitive examination for teachers in 1924. He was appointed as a teacher at the Lycée in Monaco in 1920, where he spent his entire career. He emerged on the literary scene in 1924 and won the Renaudot prize in 1926 for his novel *Nicolo-Peccavi ou l'Affaire Dreyfus à Carpentras* (*Nicolo-Peccavi or the Dreyfus Affair in Carpentras*). Lunel was mobilised in 1939 and discharged by the Vichy government in 1940. It was thanks to the personal protection of Prince Louis II that the family of Armand Lunel and several other Jewish families living in the Principality managed to escape being rounded up and deported.

150TH ANNIVERSARY OF ARTURO TOSCANINI'S BIRTH

Arturo Toscanini (1867–1957) was an Italian conductor considered by his contemporaries and the public to be one of the greatest of his era. He made his debut at the age of 19 and worked with the world's most prestigious operas, including La Scala in Milan and the Metropolitan Opera in New York. He conducted the New Year concert at the Monte-Carlo Opera in 1935. His public life, with an emphasis on freedom and democracy, stood in contrast with the despotism and intransigent perfectionism to which he subjected his musicians.

**NATIONAL SPECIES
THE RED CORAL**

Mineral by its skeleton, vegetable by appearance, but truthfully an animal, red coral, *Corallium rubrum*, has fascinated mankind since the prehistoric era. Essentially an endemic species to the Mediterranean, its magical and medicinal properties feature in many legends. The red coral lives affixed on substratum rocks from 5 m deep, but it can be most often found in depths ranging from 30 to 400 m. Over time, it grew very appreciated as a commercial commodity, notably for its use in jewellery. It is a species whose fishing is regulated.

**NATIONAL SPECIES
THE THICK-ROOTED CAMPANULA**

Perennial plant 10 to 30 cm tall, the thick-rooted bellflower, *Campanula macrorhiza*, grows on rocks in the south-east of France, but also in Spain, Italy and in Algeria. It can be found in Monaco on the rocky walls of the Rampe Major.
