



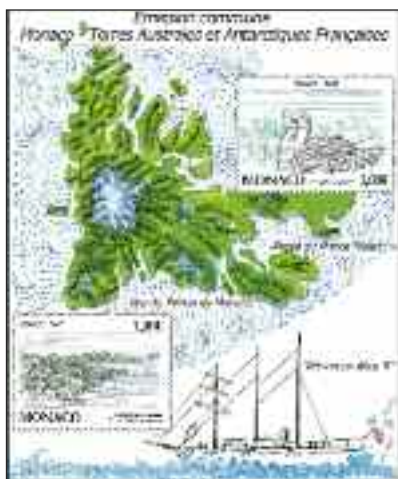

JOINT ISSUE MONACO-TAAF

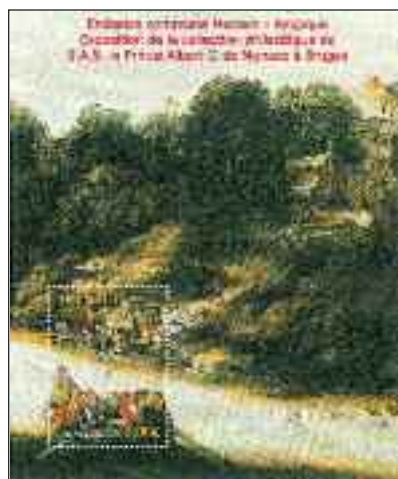
Last 9 June, at the Planète Timbres trade fair in Paris, the Principality of Monaco and TAAF (*Terres Australes et Antarctiques Françaises* / French Southern and Antarctic Lands) unveiled the slug for their joint issue honouring biodiversity, a theme dear to both parties. Located in the Kerguelen Islands, the Prince of Monaco Islands and Prince Albert Channel were named in honour of Prince Albert Ier's scientific explorations.

Its members work daily towards the conservation of biodiversity, through its vocation for the protection of birds. The stamp shows the woodchat shrike (*Lanius senator*), a species protected throughout France.

A FORMER GRIMALDI FIEF - BELFORT

The "Office des Émissions de Timbres-Poste" will participate in the "TIMBRES PASSION 2012" trade fair in Belfort (France) from 2 to 4 November 2012. There are historic ties between the Principality of Monaco and Belfort. Cardinal Mazarin held many titles including that of Count of Belfort. The Grimaldi family was granted these titles with the wedding in 1777 of Prince Honoré IV with Louise d'Aumont, descended from a niece of Cardinal Mazarin. Today, HSH Prince Albert II remains Count of Belfort.

A FORMER GRIMALDI FIEF - MATIGNON

Eldest daughter and heir to Prince Antoine Ier of Monaco, Louise-Hippolyte Grimaldi married Jacques de Goyon de Matignon in 1715. Recognised as Prince of Monaco under the name Jacques Ier on his wife's death, he remained regent during his son's minority and brought several seigniories to the Grimaldi family, including that of Matignon. The stamp features Fort-la-Latte, one of the most famous castles in Brittany. Next July, HSH Prince Albert II will return to His ancestors' home during His visit to the land of Matignon.

150th ANNIVERSARY OF THE BIRTH OF AUGUSTE LUMIÈRE

Born in Besançon in 1862, Auguste Lumière and his brother Louis invented the cinematograph. Their first film, *La Sortie des Usines Lumière* (Workers leaving the Lumière factory) was shown in Paris in 1895. The Lumière brothers also had a key role in the history of photography, by developing the autochrome, an early industrial process for colour photography.

CENTENARY OF THE DISCOVERY OF THE BUST OF NEFERTITI

150th ANNIVERSARY OF THE BIRTH OF CLAUDE DEBUSSY

Born in Saint-Germain-en-Laye in 1862, Claude Debussy entered the Conservatoire at the age of 10. In 1884, he received the "Prix de Rome" for his cantata *L'Enfant prodigue* and went to the French Academy in Rome Arts at Villa Medici. Back in Paris, he achieved his first true success with *Prélude à l'après-midi d'un faune* inspired by a poem by Mallarmé. Influenced by Chopin and Wagner, he composed works for voice, piano and orchestra.

CRUCIFIXION BY LOUIS BREA

A painter of Ligurian origin born in Nice, Louis (Ludovico) Brea was among the first to set aside the traditional codes of Gothic art to bring the region of Liguria and the Comté de Nice into the Renaissance. He remains a reference in 15th and 16th-century religious painting. His earliest known work is a *Pietà*, dated 1475 and on display at the Monastery of Cimiez in Nice, where visitors can also see a *Crucifixion*, another panel painting by Brea commissioned by the Grimaldis of Beuil and completed in 1512.
