



TINTIN IN MONEGASQUE

The third Tintin album in the Monegasque language was published on 21 November 2012. Entitled U tesoru de Rakamu u Russu (Red Rackham's Treasure), it follows on from I ori da Castafiore (The Castafiore Emerald) and U secretu d'a Licorna (The Secret of the Unicorn). A commemorative postage stamp was issued on the day the album was published. Explore the world of Tintin's creator at the Hergé Museum near Brussels, the biggest museum in the world dedicated to the author of a comic book. Hergé the illustrator. lettering artist. scriptwriter. advertising expert and occasional painter, invented a graphic style that has withstood the tests of time and fashion (www.tintin.com and www.museeherge.com). > Issue on November 21, 2012 / FDC small size

BICENTENARY OF THE VÉNÉRABLE ARCHICONFRÉRIE DE LA MISÉRICORDE

The brotherhood of White Penitents, dedicated to solidarity with the impoverished, was the first brotherhood known in Monaco. Dissensions between its members led to a split and the creation, in 1639, of a new brotherhood, the Black Penitents. In 1813, the Bishop of Nice who was also responsible for Monaco, reunited the two ancient brotherhoods. Such is the background of the current Vénérable Archiconfrérie de la Miséricorde. The stamp depicts the mosaic on the outside wall of the chapel devoted to the Virgin of Mercy in Monaco-Ville, created by Roman artist Ernesto Sprega, famous in particular for his many frescoes in the Prince's Palace.

CENTRE SPERANZA – ALBERT II

The Centre Speranza-Albert II offers therapeutic day care for people living in Monaco who suffer from Alzheimer's Disease. The Centre was born from a tripartite implication between the princely Government, the Croix-Rouge Monégasque (Monaco's Red Cross) and Monaco's municipality. The stamp features a collective work painted by patients of the Centre.

THE NUDE IN ART - OLYMPIA BY MANET

Edouard Manet painted Olympia in 1863. Although inspired by Titian's Venus of Urbino, the composition breaks away from classic aesthetics and academic painting. It triggered a shockwave in its day, because of the woman's provocative pose and because of the brand new pictorial technique. Olympia is a pivotal work; it opened the path to modernity, to the images of contemporary, non-idealised reality embraced by the impressionists.

Founded in 1963 at the initiative of Princess Grace of Monaco, the World Association of Children's Friends (Association Mondiale des Amis de l'Enfance - AMADE) endeavours to contribute to the well-being of extremely vulnerable children. It is currently chaired by H.R.H. the Princess of Hanover. The association aims above all to guarantee the autonomy of the communities it works with. creating results that last. The Red Cross was born at the initiative of one man, Henry Dunant. He helped injured soldiers at the Battle of Solferino in 1859, and then encouraged political leaders to take greater measures to protect war victims. Founded in 1863, the International Red Cross and Red Crescent movement is the biggest humanitarian network in the world. In 1888, twelve Monegasques got together to create a sports club called *Société des Régates*; it organised sailing and rowing regattas. In 1953, the Yacht Club de Monaco was founded and took over the sailing activities, while the *Société des Régates* changed its name to *Société Nautique de Monaco* and continued with the rowing. A young Monegasque oarsman representing the Principality performed brilliantly at the recent Olympic Games in London.

CLEAN TRANSPORT IN MONACO

Monaco's government has developed mobility and quality travel solutions that respect the environment. The shuttle boat powered by solar electricity, for example, is far more than a simple gimmick for the tourists: it is integrated into the transport network operated by Monaco's bus company (*Compagnie des Autobus de Monaco*). This is one concrete example of an ecological means of transport that reflects government policy. Monaco has been lending out electrically assisted bicycles since 2007. Today, there are seven stations dotted around the Principality.

150th ANNIVERSARY OF THE BIRTH OF PIERRE DE COUBERTIN

Pierre de Coubertin was born into an aristocratic family in Paris in 1863. He turned his back on the military career that had been mapped out for him, preferring the world of education. Influenced by the culture of the English-speaking world, he militated for the inclusion of sport in French schools. In 1894, he founded the International Olympic Committee to revive the Olympic Games.
