## CARE CENTRE FOR SEA TURTLES

Turtles, which are indicators of the health of the oceans, are subjected to most of the pressures that humans exert on the ocean, from the coasts to the high seas - urbanisation, overfishing and bycatch, ship strikes, pollution and the accumulation of plastic. The new care centre will draw on the experience of the Oceanographic Museum of Monaco to rescue, care for and release sea turtles. This project is part of the French Mediterranean Turtle Care Network (*Réseau Tortues de la Méditerranée Française*) in partnership with the Centre for the Study and Protection of Mediterranean Sea Turtles (*Centre d'études et de sauvegarde des tortues marines de Méditerranée*).

## BLOCK MONACOPHIL 2017

The block issued by the Office des Timbres de Monaco refers to « The philately of North and South America », the theme of the exhibition MonacoPhil 2017.

North America is represented by the unforgettable Grace Kelly (1929-1982), Hollywood star who became Princess of Monaco after marrying Prince Rainier III in 1956.

The Monegasque-Brazilian inventor and artist Hercule Florence (1804-1879) features South America. Brought up in Monaco, the young Florence emigrated to Brazil in 1824 and found himself taking part as a draughtsman in the Langsdorff expedition to the Mato Grosso. The inventor of Zoophonia and of Polygraphia, in 1833 Hercule Florence invented in Brazil a photographic process and was the first to use the word "Photographie".

## JIM CLARK

British driver Jim Clark, who was born in 1936, is one of the greatest drivers in the history of Formula 1. With 25 wins and 33 pole positions in 72 Grand Prix races, he was crowned world champion twice in 1963 and 1965, when he also won the Indianapolis 500 miles. He died prematurely in a Formula 2 race at the age of 32.

### 250<sup>TH</sup> ANNIVERSARY OF FRANÇOIS-JOSEPH BOSIO

The year 2018 will mark the 250<sup>th</sup> anniversary of the birth of Monégasque sculptor François-Joseph Bosio (1768-1845), who was a portrait painter to Napoleon I and then a professor at the School of Fine Arts. He was appointed as the first sculptor of the King in 1821. His major works are in Paris - twenty bas-reliefs for the column of the Place Vendôme, the equestrian statue of *Louis XIV* in the Place des Victoires, for which he received the title of Baron, *Henri IV as a child*, and *Aristotle and Hercules fighting with Achelous*, all three of which can be found in the Louvre museum. For the stamp design, a competition was held for all former students of the Pavillon Bosio - Monaco Art School. The winner, Céline Marin, chose to represent the sculptor and one of his major works, the Quadriga of the Carrousel Triumphant Arch, created in 1828.

### OPERA SINGERS – SELMA KURZ

Selma Kurz (1874-1933) was an Austrian singer. First of all, she sang as a mezzo-soprano, and then as a soprano, finally specialising in coloratura. She made her debut in Hamburg in 1895. In 1899, Gustav Mahler engaged her at the Vienna Opera House. She went on to perform all over the world, including at the Monte Carlo Opera. She made more than 150 recordings on 78 rpm discs.

### OPERA SINGERS – FEODOR CHALIAPIN

Russian opera singer Feodor Chaliapin (1873-1938) was considered the greatest Slavic bass of his time. In 1910, he performed in the role of Massenet's *Don Quixote* in Monte Carlo. He also bade farewell to the stage in Monaco in 1937, in *Boris Godunov*. In addition to his exceptional voice, Chaliapin embodied all the qualities of operatic art - an expressive personality, an understanding of roles, charisma and commitment to the stage.

### THE NUDE IN ART

Born in 1877, Kees Van Dongen was a Dutch painter who acquired French nationality. He was an avant-garde artist and a proponent of Fauvism. He lived in Monaco from 1949 until the time of his death in 1968. His masterpieces were acquired by the Principality of Monaco between 2004 and 2008, from his family. This stamp represents *The Night* ("La Nuit"), a work of 1922 which has belonged to the Prince's Palace in Monaco since 2007.

### THE LOTUS 49

The Lotus 49 was the first Formula 1 single-seater racing car with a stressed member engine to win a Grand Prix - the Zandvoort race in 1967 - with British driver Jim Clark at the wheel. In 1968, the Lotus 49, driven by Graham Hill, became world champion (manufacturer and driver).

### THE MERCEDES-BENZ W196

Perpetuating the myth of the Silver Arrows, the Mercedes-Benz W196 won its first Grand Prix in Reims, at the time of its first race, and dominated the world championship until the model was discontinued at the end of the 1955 season. In fourteen Grand Prix races, the W196 won 10 times (9 with Fangio and 1 with Stirling Moss), leading to Fangio being crowned world champion twice in 1954 and 1955.

### 70<sup>TH</sup> ANNIVERSARY OF THE MONEGASQUE RED CROSS

Today, the Monegasque Red Cross is presided over by H.S.H. Prince Albert II. It was founded on 3 March 1948 by Prince Louis II; it was recognised in the same year by the International Committee of the Red Cross and admitted to the International Federation of Red Cross and Red Crescent Societies. With the help of its volunteers, the Monegasque Red Cross strives to meet the challenges posed by natural disasters, armed conflicts and displaced populations. At the local level, it is active in various fields - supporting the most disadvantaged people, providing training in nursing and first aid, running crèches and other types of childcare, organising the annual Gala, etc...

### 150<sup>TH</sup> ANNIVERSARY OF MONACO'S ECOLE DES FRÈRES SCHOOL

In 1858, by his Sovereign Ordinance of 1 June 1858, Prince Charles III promulgated the basic charter for primary and secondary education in the Principality of Monaco. The Girls' School, founded by Father Barré, was run by nuns, the Ladies of Saint-Maur. As for the boys, the Brothers of the Christian Schools (Lasallians) were responsible for primary public education as of 4 October 1868. Brother Thionis - depicted on the stamp - was the first director of the House of Monaco, a position he held until 1879. Then the "crisis of vocations" gradually led the community to hand over the running to lay teachers and educators, until their final departure on 10 June 1989.
