90TH ANNIVERSARY OF THE BIRTH OF PRINCESS GRACE OF MONACO

Born on 12 November 1929 in Philadelphia, Princess Grace of Monaco would have been 90 years old this year. A magnificent actress and muse to Alfred Hitchcock, she won the Oscar for Best Actress in 1955. In 1956, she ended her acting career to marry Prince Rainier III, with whom she had three children: H.S.H Prince Albert II, H.R.H. Princess Caroline of Hanover, and H.S.H. Princess Stéphanie. A committed supporter of humanitarian causes, in 1963 she founded AMADE, also known as the World Association of Children's Friends, and then in 1964 the Princess Grace of Monaco Foundation, an international charity. She died tragically on 14 September 1982, but will remain in our hearts forever.

CENTENARY OF FAUSTO COPPI

Born in Piedmont in 1919, Fausto Coppi made his professional debut in 1939 and won the Giro d'Italia the following year. In 1949, he became the first rider ever to win both the Tour de France and the Giro d'Italia, repeating the feat in 1952, the year that Monaco made its bow as a city stage in the Tour de France. With an outstanding record, Fausto Coppi is widely seen as one of the greatest riders in the history of cycling. He revolutionised the approach to competitive sport with his focus on diet, technology, training methods and sporting medicine.

36[™] CONFERENCE OF MINISTERS OF LA FRANCOPHONIE

The Agency for Cultural and Technical Cooperation (ACCT) was founded in 1970. Now known as the International Organisation of La Francophonie (OIF), it provides an institutional forum for French speakers, working to promote the French language and foster cooperation between States and governments, whether members or observers. The Conference of Ministers of La Francophonie is one of the organisation's three governing bodies. It convenes annually, to ensure the political continuity of the Summits of Heads of State and Government. This year, it will take place in Monaco on 30 and 31 October, on the theme "Reconciling humanity and the planet: prospects in the Francophone world ahead of the OIF's 50th anniversary".

EXHIBITION AT THE GRIMALDI FORUM – DALI, A HISTORY OF PAINTING

From 6 July to 8 September 2019, the Grimaldi Forum Monaco will be hosting a summer exhibition entitled "Dalí, a history of painting". Marking the 30th anniversary of the artist's death (1904-1989), the exhibition brings together a collection of paintings, photographs and drawings produced between 1910 and 1983, showing the different stages in the artist's creative approach. It highlights the way in which the painter himself etched his name in the history of 20th century art. Visitors will discover Dali's own creative journey, recognising the various influences of other artists, to whom he paid tribute.

150[™] ANNIVERSARY OF THE BIRTH OF HENRI MATISSE

After studying law, Henri Matisse eventually devoted himself to painting and joined Gustave Moreau's workshop in 1895. He took a close interest in impressionism, before adopting the techniques of pointillism, ultimately becoming the leading figure of the fauvism movement. In addition to paintings, Matisse also produced sculptures and drawings, as well as sets and costumes for the Ballets Russes de Monte-Carlo, including for the ballet "Rouge et Noir" by Léonide Massine depicted on the stamp. A major figure of the 20th century, his influence on American and German art was significant.

BICENTENARY OF THE BIRTH OF JACQUES OFFENBACH

The undisputed master of the operetta, Jacques Offenbach (1819-1880) conquered lyrical stages the world over in the second half of the 19th century, with his unique, entertaining musical style and stunning virtuosity. A celebrated cellist, maestro, and theatre director, Offenbach is one of a handful of composers to have seen their music played and enjoyed by audiences. His best known works are *Orpheus in the Underworld, The Grand Duchess of Gerolstein, and The Tales of Hoffman.*

50[™] ANNIVERSARY OF THE MOON LANDINGS

After taking off from Kennedy Space Centre on 16 July 1969, the astronauts of the Apollo 11 mission landed on the Moon four days later. It was the first time such a feat had ever been achieved. The following day, a giant leap was made for mankind, as Neil Armstrong and Buzz Aldrin emerged from the Eagle lunar module to set foot on the Earth's only natural satellite.

150[™] ANNIVERSARY OF THE BIRTH OF GANDHI

After training as a lawyer, Mohandas Karamchand Gandhi practised in South Africa for twenty years. During that period, he experimented with passive, non-violent civil disobedience. He returned to India in 1915, devoting his energies to overthrowing British colonial rule and becoming the moral leader of the Indian National Congress. His attachment to tradition, austere lifestyle and numerous spells in prison made him a very popular figure. He earned the nickname "Mahatma" (the venerable). He played a key role in India's independence in 1947. Gandhi was assassinated by a Hindu extremist in 1948. He was the inspiration for many freedom and civil rights movements around the world.

500[™] ANNIVERSARY OF THE FIRST **CIRCUMNAVIGATION OF THE EARTH**

In 1518, Charles I of Spain (later Charles V, Holy Roman Emperor) agreed to finance Ferdinand Magellan's plan to sail to the Moluccas (present day Indonesia), islands with highly sought-after spices, via the south-west passage. In September 1519, five ships left Sanlùcar. By December, they had crossed the Atlantic and reached Brazil. On 1 November 1520, the strait between the Atlantic and the Pacific was discovered. It would later come to be known as the Strait of Magellan. In March 1521, the fleet arrived in the Philippines. Magellan was killed in a battle with the indigenous population. Captain Elcano continued the voyage and eventually reached the Moluccas. The fleet returned to Seville on 4 September 1522.

VALMONT

Jacques IV of Matignon (1689-1751) was a descendant of the Estouteville family, lords of Valmont who built the château in 1110. He married Louise-Hippolyte Grimaldi in 1715 and acceded to the throne in 1731, taking the regnal name Jacques I of Monaco and bringing the Valmont lands to the House of Grimaldi. The château remained in the hands of the Grimaldis until 1805. H.S.H. Prince Albert II will return to the lands of His ancestors in September.

ROMANS-SUR-ISÈRE

Under the Treaty of Péronne, signed on 14 September 1641, between Louis XIII of France and the Prince of Monaco, Honoré II, the Principality of Monaco became a protectorate of France and lost its Spanish possessions, in the Kingdom of Naples, along with their income. By way of compensation, Louis XIII granted French lands including the Duchy of Valentinois. Under the terms of the agreement, numerous towns such as Romanssur-Isère, Valence, Chabeuil, Montélimar, Crest, and others, became dependencies of the Grimaldi family, although the family did not hold sovereignty or political jurisdiction over them.

The reproduction of this bird in the Principality of Monaco is indicative of good ecological conditions, which are necessary for this protected, iconic species.
